2003 Napa Valley Cabernet Franc

TASTING NOTES

For the fifth year in a row, Keenan has bottled a one hundred percent Cabernet Franc varietal. This wine was produced only from grapes grown on the Keenan Estate in Spring Mountain District. A small portion of Keenan's 2003 Cabernet Franc was blended into the 2003 Napa Valley Merlot, while the remaining wine was bottled on its own. Only 280 cases of the '03 Cabernet Franc were produced.

The 2003 Cabernet Franc was aged in 33% new French and American oak barrels for eighteen months. The finished wine shows intense ripe black cherry, plum and floral aromas. Hints of earth and slight herbaceous notes add complexity as the wine "opens up". This wine has wonderful structure and will age for many years to come.
